

Dartmouth College Intramural Basketball Winter 2018

1. Dartmouth Intramurals are for Dartmouth students, staff and faculty. Spouses, partners, alums, parents, siblings, visiting friends, community members, etc. are not eligible.
2. Players must sign-in with IM supervisor with their Dartmouth College ID. No ID = No Play!
3. Players must wear proper not marking court shoes – no barefeet, socks only other non-court shoes (e.g. loafers, boots, flip flips, slippers, etc.)
4. Game Time is forfeit time. A legal team is 5 players; teams may start and finish with 4. A co-rec team must have 2 women. If there is not a legal team, the game is recorded as a forfeit.
5. Men may play on only one men's (Granite or Moosilauke – not both) .Women may play on only one men's team – not both divisions. These players may also play on a co-rec team. Co-rec players may play on only one Co-Rec team (Granite or Moosilauke – not both). If a team is short-handed, it can play with “borrowed” players, the score is recorded as a forfeit.
6. Varsity basketball players on the 2015-16 roster at any time after October 15 are ineligible for IM play.
7. Referees will call the games following recreational basketball rules.
8. Game blocks are 45 minutes: 5 minute warm-up, two 15-minute halves with a 3-minute half-time; each team is allowed 2 45-second time-outs in the game. The game clock will stop only for timeouts and in the last 2 minutes of a game where the score is within 4 points.
9. No alcohol or illegal drugs allowed. Intoxicated or impaired players will not be allowed on the court.
10. Any teams involved in fighting will be removed from IM play and the team play fee is deposited.
11. Play fees are returned at the end of the season to teams with no forfeits or violations of IM policies.
