

Dartmouth Intramurals Winter 2018 Hockey

Dartmouth Intramurals are for Dartmouth students, staff and faculty. No spouses, partners, alums, parents, siblings, community members, etc.

A legal team is 5 skaters and a goalie; a forfeit is called if there is not a legal team on the ice at game time.

Team limit each game: 11 players/team (10 skaters and a goalie).

Players must sign-in with IM supervisor with their Dartmouth College ID. No ID = No Play!

Green (Rookie League) teams cannot have club hockey or retired varsity players. Green teams should not have any experienced hockey players.

Moosilauke teams may have two club hockey players per game, no retired varsity players. Teams with more than two club players or any retired varsity players must play in the Granite League.

Players may play on only one team (Granite, Moosilauke or Green – not one in multiple divisions). Women may play on a men's team. Women who play on a men's team are not allowed to play on a women's team.

Varsity hockey players listed at any time after October 15 on the 15-16 rosters are not eligible for IM play.

Play fees are returned after the season to teams with no forfeits and no policy violations. Policy violations include, but are not limited to playing with ineligible players, exceeding the player limit, intoxication, checking, fighting, abuse of equipment, disrespect of IM staff and unsportsmanlike behavior.

Teams are responsible for their own sticks and tape. There are some sticks for loan, but no guarantees.

No alcohol or illegal drugs in Thompson arena. Any team in violation will be removed from IM play. This includes your fans. Intoxicated skaters will not be allowed on the ice.
